

Our main production plant has a builtup area of approximately 7,000 square metres, it has a foundry, a fabrication workshop and two machining shops.







Foundry

Our foundry is designed and built specifically for the production of copper alloy castings of sterngear equipment. It has a melting capacity of approximately 6 tonnes of electric furnace which delivers high quality melt.











Healthy Margin Growth

- Direct materials in FY2008 and FY2007 accounted for 26.6% of Revenue and 25.3% of Revenue respectively compared to 38.0% and 30.5% in FY2005 and FY2006
- Material cost exposure is minimized by typically fixing raw materials prices at point of securing contracts from customers
- Customers are generally willing to pay to shorten delivery lead time
